CHRISTIAN STEWARDSHIP

Bible Text: 2 Kings 22:1-7

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Prayer

Heavenly Father, we bless and worship Your holy name, thank You for the gift of life and Your mercies over us, we appreciate You and ask that You bless us through Your Word, also empower the teacher from the throne of grace, bless the hearers and make us doers of Your word in Jesus name, Amen.

Study

If we look into the world currently we will see that the world is becoming churchy as the church is becoming worldly, In fact if we look carefully, we'd discover that those who have never heard about Christ before can claim to be Christians because there is no difference at all between those who profess Christ from those who worship idols, all these has come to be, not because of any other thing than the way the Christians of this generation live their lives to present Christ to a sinful world. That is why we'll be looking into the topic which I call **Christian Stewardship** beloved, I would like you to follow today's study carefully, and not only follow it, but be the doer of it because it is only the doer of the word that is wise, not the hearer only.

What is stewardship?

The word stewardship is derived from the mother word **steward** which means one employed in a large household or estates to manage domestic concerns (such as the supervision of servants, collection of rents, and keeping of accounts) therefore stewardship means the conducting, supervising, or managing of something. I believe we all know whom a Christian is but for those who do not know who a Christian is, lets define it in a simple term, a Christian is someone one who is Christlike, that is, who live the life of Christ in total obedience to Him.

2 Kings 22:1-7 KJV

Josiah was eight years old when he began to reign, and he reigned thirty and one years in Jerusalem. And his mother's name was Jedidah, the daughter of Adaiah of Boscath. [2] And he did that which was right in the sight of the Lord, and walked in all the way of David his father, and turned not aside to the right hand or to the left. [3] And it came to pass in the eighteenth year of king Josiah, that the king sent Shaphan the son of Azaliah, the son of Meshullam, the scribe, to the house of the Lord, saying, [4] Go up to Hilkiah the high priest, that he may sum the silver which is brought into the house of the Lord, which the keepers of the door have gathered of the people: [5] And let them deliver it

into the hand of the doers of the work, that have the oversight of the house of the Lord : and let them give it to the doers of the work which is in the house of the Lord, to repair the breaches of the house, [6] Unto carpenters, and builders, and masons, and to buy timber and hewn stone to repair the house. [7] Howbeit there was no reckoning made with them of the money that was delivered into their hand, because they dealt faithfully.

Please, read these verses carefully. Our focus will be on verse 7.

Often times, when we hear the word **steward** what comes to our mind first are those serving at a bar, hotel, governments house etc. There are professional stewards that would welcome visitors with mesmerizing smiles that could make him feel at home even right from the door post. However, stewardship are in levels and let us not forget what it meaning is, that it has to do with conducting, supervising, and managing something, therefore, we would not be wrong to say that a steward is a supervisor or a manager, but at the same time a steward is a servant, because he is to serve the one that gave him the job.

Is someone still with me?

In the body of Christ everybody is a steward, whether they hold any position in the church or not, it doesn't matter, we are all managing one thing or the other in life in which Christ must reflect in, therefore, stewardship calls for the careful and responsible management of anything entrusted in one's care. As children of God we must not only be stewards but faithful ones. This is why faithfulness is one of the fruit of the spirit, God calls for faithfulness in everything we do; not only in the church or at fellowships but everywhere we find ourselves, although many are not faithful stewards even in the house of God not to talk of outside the house of God and because of their unfaithfulness in stewardship they have tarnished the name of Christ. In our Bible text, we are made to understand that in the 18th year of King Josiah's reign they started a reconstruction project which is to repair the Temple of God, just the same way we have building projects these days when we build worship centers, children's church, teenagers church, youth church, parks, toilets etc. But this time they wanted to repair the temple because of the adverse damages that had been done to it, some set of people were chosen to collect money from people as a form of revenue to achieve this reconstruction project. Therefore, the priests were to gather the money and hand it over to those supervising the workers, that is, those working at the reconstruction site. But the surprising thing there was that the king said that they should not bother asking the supervisors to account for the money delivered into their hands, "it's strange" but there was a reason for this instruction, the reason is that these men were "thoroughly honest" 2 Kings 22:7 GNT **The men in charge of the work are THOROUGHLY HONEST, so there is no need to require them to account for the funds.** they did everything faithfully.

As the supervisors of the work, the workers might not have known how much was committed into their hands, which can make them think of diverting some amount of money into their personal pulse and pay these workers stipends but they did not do so

but they dealt faithfully with the money committed into their hands, if we look into the world today, can such instruction be given to most Christians? Looking into the Christianity of these days we will see that one of the major problems of many so-called Christian is money!. Unfaithfulness with money has made many lose their integrity, even the leaders, from the top to the least cannot be trusted with funds, no account was bothered to be made by these men because they exhibited the fruit of faithfulness in stewardship.

To be a steward is not enough but to have a good character that singles a man out is what makes the difference, but today, those whom we assume to be trustworthy are the worst when it comes to money matters, a lot of atrocities are being committed just because of money, due to lack of honesty and trust, cameras are being installed in the room where tithes and offerings are being counted by **Christian brethren** in the church. It's shameful! It is not only in money matters that faithful stewardship is required, we are being made to know in 1 Corinthians 4:2 KJV that **Moreover it is required in stewards, that a man be found faithful.** This tells us that it is required that as stewards we should be found faithful, we should prove ourselves worthy of trust, those men must have been tested before earning so much trust. Many people have failed the simple test that was given to them, which should have earned them integrity and the trust that would have connected them to their places of destiny but they missed the opportunity because of little dishonesty, and because they were not faithful in a little thing the riches of the kingdom could not be committed into their hands.

Luke 16:10 AMP **He who is faithful in a very little [thing] is faithful also in much, and he who is dishonest and unjust in a very little [thing] is dishonest and unjust also in much.** Here, the Lord Jesus Christ summed it up. As some would say "let me get to the top first then I would be faithful but for now lets cut corners." But the Lord is saying such people would remain dishonest no matter the position they get to in life. Faithful stewardship is expected in every area of our lives as saints and it begins when we have little, when small things are committed into our hands.

Therefore we would consider just three areas where we are expected to prove ourselves as true stewards of Christ.

1. Stewardship in the Home: The act of stewardship begins right from the family, husbands and wives must be faithful stewards committed to their marriage vows by this their children would learn how to be faithful and honest. Both husband and wife must be ready to serve each other without expecting a reward for it, honest discussions must be made and these should be in areas such as finance, spiritual and relationship with friends and families. Once an agreement is made by both, stewardship posits that both should stay true to the agreement, for example, in a situation where both agrees not to allow any visitor of an opposite sex sleep overnight when the other is not around, none should break such, as it could lead to serious misunderstanding and lack of trust among them if broken, the moment they both realize that they are doing the other party service which must be honestly done, then they would both enjoy their home. There are

couples that borrow money from each other, faithful stewardship demands that you pay back as at when due. Stewardship demands that as a wife the money you see in your husbands pocket while doing the laundry should be returned to him if no initial agreement was made that you could take such money. As parents what you do in the presence of your children is what they would emulate, It's disheartening to see mothers telling their children to inflate their school fees so that their father can give them more, this is dishonesty and the children are already learning it. There are some parents that borrow money from their children but will never pay back, these are not true stewards and as Christians we must not be found in such ways.

Truthfulness between couples, your wife or husband should be able to trust whatever thing you tell them. As a woman because you know that the man would complain that his food was not prepared on time, then you lied that there was hold up on your way from the market, this is damnable. As a father of your home, you cannot be a faithful steward when you do not provide for your home, not only financially, but also spiritually and morally, your position as the priest of your home should not be empty or taken over by your wife. The spiritual climate of your home should be well monitored and controlled by you and this requires constant vigils, raising spiritual altars in the home, prophetic declarations on each members of your family, this is when you can prove yourself to be a faithful steward before the Lord. It's painful that the family altar of most homes have broken into piece and the devil has now gotten the chance to penetrate because of the dishonesty in stewardship of the father of the house. I pray that, if we have such homes here, that the Lord Jesus Christ Himself would reinstate the family with His precious blood, Amen. Every member of the family should be trusted for their words because they have been taught the act of faithfulness in service both to God and humanity. Since we know that our stewardship (Services) as Christians is not to man but to God. We must therefore live as if it's God Himself we are dealing with.

2. Stewardship in Christian Gatherings: This means in the church, bible schools, Christian fellowships, Christian seminars, everywhere Christians are gathered we should not forget our bible text that talks about what happened when they were repairing the temple during king Josiah's reign. A similar thing also happened in 2 Kings 12:11-15 KJV **And they gave the money, being told, into the hands of them that did the work, that had the oversight of the house of the Lord : and they laid it out to the carpenters and builders, that wrought upon the house of the Lord, [12] And to masons, and hewers of stone, and to buy timber and hewed stone to repair the breaches of the house of the Lord, and for all that was laid out for the house to repair it. [13] Howbeit there were not made for the house of the Lord bowls of silver, snuffers, basins, trumpets, any vessels of gold, or vessels of silver, of the money that was brought into the house of the Lord : [14] But they gave that to the workmen, and repaired therewith the house of the Lord. [15] Moreover they reckoned not with the men, into whose hand they delivered the money to be bestowed on workmen: FOR THEY DEALT FAITHFULLY.**

Joash also told these set of people not to bother giving account of the money placed in their custody when they were repairing the temple. In the same way we have Carpenters

and builders working stewards, that was the same way we have those supervising them as stewards. It is not everyone that might be placed to supervise building projects in the church but whenever we find ourselves to serve, then we must do it faithfully as to the Lord. We should know that if we must be called saints in heaven we must first live as saints here on earth, that is why we must always put heaven in view in whatever thing we do. Just because the world has entered the church does not mean we should allow the things and the ways of the world have their ways/grips in our lives. Dishonesty is not what is becoming of saints, there are those who serve as choristers in total unfaithfulness, they fight because of microphone, they envy others because they do not have the same measure of gift like the them, thereby getting slack in their duties towards the Lord. Everyone has to know that the part we play in every Christian gathering is not to men but to God, we should not seek to please men or to receive peoples praise.

God doesn't view things the way man looks, God checks the motive behind every action of men so He does not only judge what we do, He also judges the motive behind what we are doing. God does not hold us responsible only for the sins we commit but He also holds us responsible for the sin we would commit if we have the opportunity to. That was what happened to Lucifer, Lucifer was one of the heavenly stewards but was cast down to the Earth for unfaithfulness in form of pride, when he had not even committed the sin he thought about. Isaiah 14:12-15 KJV **How art thou fallen from heaven, O Lucifer, son of the morning! how art thou cut down to the ground, which didst weaken the nations! [13] For thou hast SAID IN THINE HEART, I will ascend heaven, I will exalt my throne above the stars of God: I will sit also upon the mount of the congregation, in the sides of the north: [14] I will ascend above the heights of the clouds; I will be like the most High. [15] Yet thou shalt be brought down to hell, to the sides of the pit.** If Lucifer had the opportunity to carry out his thoughts he would have carried it out so he was judged before he even carried out his thoughts, therefore beloved, truly you are serving in the household of faith and men are seeing you as a vibrant Christian who loves God and working in God's vineyard tirelessly, but what kind of heart are you using to do the Lords work, Is it a sincere one or biased one full of envy, hatred, jealousy, anger, incontinent?, We should not forget that the position of our hearts toward the work of God that is committed into our hands really matters a lot as stewards when it comes to God rewarding us.

There are many well known people in the household of faith that will not receive half of the reward that someone who is not even known at all in the church would receive. It is all about everyone being faithful in the area the Lord has called them to serve. A man can be on the pulpit preaching for fifty years and a woman can be in the pew praying in her closet for ten years interceding for the church and would receive greater reward than that of the man preaching for fifty years because she is at the place where God has called her to be and doing what He has sent her to do, unlike the man that was doing the work that God did not send Him to do. Yes! He might be popular and vibrant, well respected and honoured by men, but might be doing dead works. It is more than

working for God, but doing the right thing at the right time. Let's not forget the parable of the three servants Matthew 25:14-15 KJV **For the kingdom of heaven is as a man travelling into a far country, who called his own servants, and delivered unto them his goods. [15] And unto one he gave five talents, to another two, and to another one; to every man according to his several ability; and straightway took his journey.** Please you can go through the chapter again and read more about this parable. There is something I want us to understand from this parable, the master of these servants divided his goods according to the proportion that he knows each of them can handle. Now, it is not about how much was committed into the hands of each servant but how profitable each servant can be with the little or much that has been committed into his hand, that was why he commended the one with five talents and also commended the one with two talents in the same way, because they were profitable, it wasn't because the one with one talent had one talent, that wasn't the reason he rebuked him and punished him, no! it is because he was not profitable, assuming he gained one more talent, he would have received the same reward with someone who had five. That is how it is as stewards of Christ we must be profitable with whatever Christ has deposited in us.

So it is wrong to envy someone who has about three gifts, simply because you have only one then you continue to allow bitterness in your heart, toward such person, it is wrong. If God has given you one gift, let it be profitable as a faithful steward, let it yield more fruits and you'll receive the same reward with someone who has twelve gifts and also did the same thing. That is why the Lord Jesus Christ said unto whom much is given, much is expected, assuming someone with five goods trades and bring back two goods more, then such a person is unprofitable but someone with two goods trades and brings back two goods more then such a person is profitable, so it is not all about many gifts, it is not all about many talents, it is about how each and every one of us are able to maximize the little we have been given for the profit of the Kingdom of God, *Somebody was already sleeping*

When the Lord Jesus Christ got to the temple and found the people buying and selling, in holy anger He flogged them out and His disciples remembered what was written concerning Him. John 2:17 KJV **And his disciples remembered that it was written, The zeal of thine house hath eaten me up.** He was a faithful steward of His Father while on earth that was why He could not accept the evil done in the house of God. There are some people who are seeing that things are already going wrong in some particular sections of the church and they have the capability and the potential to change things for better but they are behaving nonchalantly about it, these set of people are not faithful in stewardship. Those who steal money in the church too, there are some pastors, ushers, accountants and the likes who fall into this category, they are only endangering their souls, they have proved unfaithful and the Lord will never commit the true riches of the Kingdom into their hands unless they repent and retribute. There are pastors who take out of the church money secretly and will not return borrowed ones too, these set of people are unfaithful stewards before the Lord.

There was a story about an Elder that kept on borrowing money from the church and

did not pay back, so it got to a point he wanted to borrow another one then someone challenged him among the leadership of church, he told the elder directly that he has not paid the ones he borrowed and is still requesting for another , that he will not be given, this has been going on for long because other people feared this man who has been borrowing the money and has not been returning it, so the Elder who is the borrower got angry and said, so this man is the one who has the audacity to talk among everybody, it was not more than seven days that the man who challenged the elder died, the elder killed this man because he spoke the truth right inside the church of God, if things like these are happening right in the Church of God then what kind of Steward is that elder? what kind of example is he laying down for others?

Things like this are not to be heard in the church of God, those who sing, teach, preach etc should do so to the glory of God. Ephesians 6:6-7 KJV **Not with eyeservice, as menpleasers; but as the servants of Christ, doing the will of God from the heart; [7] With good will doing service, as to the Lord, and not to men:** God has been calling some people to work for Him in some departments of the church and till now they have refused, some are working in the wrong department of the church where God has not called them to serve Him, yet they know about this but they keep on squeezing themselves there. These set of people are not truthful stewards. It's said of some particular set of pastors in training who do steal foodstuffs, use other peoples things secretly without permission, right inside the Bible school where they were being trained as pastors, If these set of people can be doing such a thing right from the Bible school what will they do when they are finally placed as the head of a church.

This is the time for us to be weary of hypocritical form of Christianity and be sincere with our walk with God. Some Christians inside the church are the ones that knows the witches, wizard, drunkards, fornicators, adulterers, liars, pretenders, and every other things about people in the church they go about gossiping about matters they are not sure about, thereby spreading falsehood right inside the Church of God, The Lord does not delight in such people as they are those who pull down His church, no faithful steward would have the time to gossip about others because he would be very busy in service. Gossip and other works of the flesh are all civilian affairs when it comes to spiritual matters. 2 Timothy 2:4 KJV **No man that warreth entangleth himself with the affairs of this life; that he may please him who hath chosen him to be a soldier.**

Christ faithful stewards are always busy with what God has committed into their hands they will not have time to reply gossips, haters, fight people or even engage in arguments because they recognise that they are in service to God and not men, that is why they will not be discouraged by what people say neither would they leave Christ because someone of high esteem behave below their expectations. There are those who leaves the church because they were insulted, some left because they felt the pastor was preaching against the bad things they were doing, these set of people are not serious stewards of Jesus Christ and He does not delight in them,they have to repent or else they will be unfit to enter into the kingdom of God.

Stewardship in the Society: The truth of the matter is that a man who is not a good representative of Christ in the family and the in the Church, will not be faithful in the secular world and this is the most strategic place where we are representing Christ because it includes those who are of the same faith with us and those who are not of the same faith with us (sinners) and our conducts would tell what stuff we are made of. Beloved, why many sinners are yet to give their lives to Christ is because of the way we live our life before their eyes, they do not see any difference in it from theirs. We are unfaithful where they too are unfaithful, dishonest like them, in fact some so called Christians are the ring leaders perpetuating evil and worse than those who do not know God at their work place. If auditors are coming to audit accounts, they are the ones that would come up with the ideas of changing figures to cover their misconduct and misappropriation of fund, Is this the best to be a steward of Christ?

I can remember many years ago when I was still in secondary school Jss 1 precisely, there was a boy named Chukwudi in my class then, some of us decided to do daily contribution of money, so that we could save and share the money at the end of the day so we decided that he would be the one to keep the money, but alas! Chukwudi stole our money, he might have forgotten by now, but here I am, I did not forget what he did, although I left the money, I saw him in the market years after that time and greeted him, but did not talk about it, but as soon as I saw him, I remembered the money again, though it doesn't mean that I did not forgive him. That is how it is, when we live our life in untruthfulness and unrighteousness, there are things we might have forgotten that people will never forget, look at Chukwudi's matter which happened more than thirteen years ago its still fresh in my memory, if he wants to take up a political position tomorrow and I'm to endorse him, would I be able to do that when he had proved unfaithful in the little that was committed into his hands years ago, If I endorse him, it would be unrighteousness on my part because I would not be truthful to the point that I know he might still be living in such behavior, even if he has changed now, the past is still ringing and it has discredited him. The reason why may people are still at a point, suffering seriously and cannot be rendered assistance is because of the life they are living. They are crafty, yet they call it sharpness, they are deceptive yet they call it wisdom. This mentality is that of the world and the worse aspect is that Christians who should not be part of it has imbibed such lifestyle. Those who are to be transformed by the renewing of their minds to present Christ in His full measure to sinners, are the ones spearheading ungodliness.

Many years ago, Christians were known for honesty and are trusted by the people of the world because of their high level of integrity, but today, they are the most corrupt. The increasing number of churches and Bible Schools has not changed anything. Most of these churches and Schools has failed in training and building faithful stewards because what drives many of them is money. And those attending are after certificate and not the transformational power of God's word. So they get certificate with divine endorsement. Someone talked about how pastors at a particular Bible school did examination malpractice, and these are the set of people who are to graduate to lead

others in the church who would then go into the society to represent Christ. It's shameful!. Can these set of people preach any transformational message, no man can give others what he himself do not have. Many came out of these schools as half backed Stewards of Christ. If not, why should an invigilator be needed in a Bible School during exam. To the glory of God, some time ago I thought within myself in an exam hall, that if everyone in the hall were to be like me, no invigilator would be needed in the hall and there would be no form of exam malpractice. How many of the Christians we have these days can say this? They do not want people to call them names, so they do things they are not expected to do. Which now makes it that, how we live doesn't preach what we carry, I pray that God will put the Spirit of honesty and truthfulness in our lives in Jesus Christ name.

Stewardship in Christ entails that one be true even in the face of hardship, be true even in suffering, be true even when everyone is against you, you will be tested, tried and persecuted for your stand but remain truthful and just. There are those who would get to work by 8:40am and register 7:30am in the log book, some selling in the market would lie that they bought an item for an higher price whereas it's not so. This is because they want the buyer to buy it at an high price. Christians now give colors to lies. White lie, red lie, blue lie... And repackage falsehood even in the society where they are to shine as an exemplary light. We have to check our lives if we are not tarnishing the name of Christ among unbelievers, some find it hard to greet people in their neighborhood, if they are greeted they would hardly respond, they see everyone around as sinners. Some can never share what they have with others, even if they are begged to, beloved, this is not how to represent Christ, a faithful steward would be a salt to those around him, and an enviable way of life would be produced clearly in him.

How A Life Can Produce Faithful Stewardship In Christ.

1. Through the fear of God
2. By the love of God
3. Through the Zeal for God's work.

1. Through the fear of God: when we fear God we would reverence Him and by this will be careful not to displease Him. This would make us have it in mind that He is omnipresent, omniscient, and omnipotent. We would know how to conduct ourselves wherever we find ourselves because of His all-seeing eyes. The fear of the Lord is the beginning of wisdom, **this kind of fear produces the wisdom required to be faithful to God. Job 28:28 KJV And unto man he said, Behold, the fear of the Lord, that is wisdom; and to depart from evil is understanding.** It is because the fear of God has lost its grip in the heart of many Christians that is why they do not care about the terror of God on those who do evil as such they lack understanding.

2. By the Love of God: Jesus Christ said if you love me keep my commandments. John 15:10 KJV **If ye keep my commandments, ye shall abide in my love; even as I have kept**

my Father's commandments, and abide in his love. A man who serves God without loving Him would only do so out of compulsion or hypocrisy. Keeping of God's commandments which is meant to hip us faithful stewards would be burdensome instead of being a blessing to them. The issue with many today is that the deep love for God is not in their hearts. The love of God in the heart of a child of God would always help him to behave circumspectly because He does not want to hurt Him.

3. Through the Zeal for God's work: The zeal we have for the things of God helps us to be faithful in our duty post as Stewards. This was reflected in our Lord Jesus Christ in Psalm 69:9 KJV **For the zeal of thine house hath eaten me up; and the reproaches of them that reproached thee are fallen upon me.** The reproaches of those who reproached His Father fell on Him. He could not bear anyone profaning the name of God. It's a pity today that even Christians join unbelievers to make fun of sacred things. They do not have any zeal toward God that could make them correct these set of people so they join them to laugh, what a shame! When we create a genuine zeal for the work of God, we would do it wholeheartedly as to the Lord.

If you are yet to be a faithful steward in God's vineyard, this is a call for you to take it up now, it's time to drop that hypocritical way of life to lay hold on the genuine artillery and serve in truth and Spirit. And I pray that we all will not lose our rewards in Jesus Christ name. Amen!
