God has made His right hand side to be the seat of mercy, help, grace, His Righteousness, glory, intercession, mediation, mediation, the High Priest and many other. Man should turn to the Throne of Grace to find help in time of need.

Hebrews 4:16 King James Version (KJV)

¹⁶ Let us therefore come boldly unto the throne of grace, that we may obtain mercy, and find grace to help in time of need.

The mercy of God has been purchased by the blood of Jesus Christ. Man need to count the blood of Jesus Christ as worthy of the mercy that they have received from God. Man that count the blood of Jesus Christ unworthy will not find mercy. God will have His vengeance upon the people that will count the blood of Jesus Christ unworthy. God will judge all the people that will count the blood of Jesus Christ as unworthy.

Hebrews 10:28-30 King James Version (KJV)

²⁸ He that despised Moses' law died without mercy under two or three witnesses:

²⁹ Of how much sorer punishment, suppose ye, shall he be thought worthy, who hath trodden under foot the Son of God, and hath counted the blood of the covenant, wherewith he was sanctified, an unholy thing, and hath done despite unto the Spirit of grace?

³⁰ For we know him that hath said, Vengeance belongeth unto me, I will recompense, saith the Lord. And again, The Lord shall judge his people.

God does not function outside of mercy. God only functions from the perspective, context and framework of mercy. Everything in His Word, hands on mercy:

- Mercy provides a way where there is no way.
- Mercy saves man from afflictions.
- Mercy saves man from trouble.
- Mercy saves man from death.
- Mercy saves man from all adversities.

All the provisions of God sit in mercy. Everything of God sits in mercy.

I trust that this book will encourage you and provide a broader perspective to mercy.

The mercy of God is needed in all of everyday living.

CHAPTER 2: THE MERCY OF GOD

Mercy is one of the cornerstones of the Word of God. Before looking at mercy from the perspective of the New Testament, there are numerous references to mercy in the Old Testament. These help form a view and picture on God's perspective and overall context relating to mercy.

God is very merciful. He grants mercy to all people. God has given Jesus Christ to the entire world as a demonstration of His mercy. The mercy of God mostly always works together with the truth of God.

God gives His mercy to man which saves man's life. God's mercy protects and preserves man from evil.

Genesis 19:19 King James Version (KJV)

¹⁹ Behold now, thy servant hath found grace in thy sight, and thou hast magnified thy mercy, which thou hast shewed unto me in saving my life; and I cannot escape to the mountain, lest some evil take me, and I die:

God's mercy does not leave His people destitute. God's mercy comes through for His children and walks with them wherever they go. Mercy goes before and surrounds man all the time.

Genesis 24:27 King James Version (KJV)

²⁷ And he said, Blessed be the Lord God of my master Abraham, who hath not left destitute my master of his mercy and his truth: I being in the way, the Lord led me to the house of my master's brethren.

God's mercy is always on and with His children. His mercy causes favour and blessings to come upon man. Mercy has no boundaries. Even in the darkest hours of life, mercy comes through. In prisons, fire, raging seas, deserts, mercy comes through. Mercy is underpinned by God's love.

Genesis 39:21 King James Version (KJV)

²¹ But the Lord was with Joseph, and shewed him mercy, and gave him favour in the sight of the keeper of the prison.

God's mercy goes with His children all the time. God's mercy extends to children. God's children will also experience mercy before man. Children of God need to trust Him for His mercy.

Genesis 43:14 King James Version (KJV)

¹⁴ And God Almighty give you mercy before the man, that he may send away your other brother, and Benjamin. If I be bereaved of my children, I am bereaved.

God's mercy leads His people. His mercy leads to their redemption from slavery, captivity, prisons, death, poverty, sickness diseases and other afflictions. God's mercy ensures that He will never leave His children alone nor forsake them. God is always there even if man may not be able to realise that.

Exodus 15:13 King James Version (KJV)

¹³ Thou in thy mercy hast led forth the people which thou hast redeemed: thou hast guided them in thy strength unto thy holy habitation.

Mercy knows no boundaries. Mercy has no limits. Mercy is available to everyone that needs it. Mercy does not sleep nor go on holiday. Mercy can and will rest upon multitudes of people at the same time. God is rich and vast in mercy. Man can never exhaust the mercies of God.

Exodus 20:6 King James Version (KJV)

⁶ And shewing mercy unto thousands of them that love me, and keep my commandments.

The earthly mercy seat is a mimic of the real mercy seat in heaven. Jesus Christ is now seated at the Throne of Grace. He is seated at the mercy seat. Under the Old Covenant, they prepared a mercy seat which was a mimic of the real mercy seat where Jesus Christ is now seated. Man can bow down before Jesus Christ in worship and find mercy. God wants His children to exercise boldness when they come before Him to find mercy.

Exodus 25:17-22 King James Version (KJV)

- ¹⁷ And thou shalt make a mercy seat of pure gold: two cubits and a half shall be the length thereof, and a cubit and a half the breadth thereof.
- ¹⁸ And thou shalt make two cherubims of gold, of beaten work shalt thou make them, in the two ends of the mercy seat.
- ¹⁹ And make one cherub on the one end, and the other cherub on the other end: even of the mercy seat shall ye make the cherubims on the two ends thereof.
- ²⁰ And the cherubims shall stretch forth their wings on high, covering the mercy seat with their wings, and their faces shall look one to another; toward the mercy seat shall the faces of the cherubims be.
- ²¹ And thou shalt put the mercy seat above upon the ark; and in the ark thou shalt put the testimony that I shall give thee.
- ²² And there I will meet with thee, and I will commune with thee from above the mercy seat, from between the two cherubims which are upon the ark of the testimony, of all things which I will give thee in commandment unto the children of Israel.

The Old Testament mercy seat mimicked the mercy seat that Jesus Christ was to sit upon

and presides over the Throne of Grace. The key principle is that God knows that man needs mercy and He has established a process and an institution through Jesus Christ where man can now go before the throne of grace to find mercy.

Exodus 26:34 King James Version (KJV)

³⁴ And thou shalt put the mercy seat upon the ark of the testimony in the most holy place.

Jesus Christ meets with man at the Throne of Grace. The mercy seat is Jesus Christ's permanent seat. Man simply have to go boldly before the Throne of Grace that they might find mercy. Children of God should learn to have the boldness to go before the Throne of grace and receive mercy from Jesus Christ.

Exodus 30:6 King James Version (KJV)

⁶ And thou shalt put it before the vail that is by the ark of the testimony, before the mercy seat that is over the testimony, where I will meet with thee.

The earthly tabernacle and its infrastructure was made with a picture of what the heavenly realm looked like. God has made a tabernacle in heaven from His own hands and not the hands of man. God has made Jesus Christ to sit on His right hand side where there is mercy. God dispenses His mercy through Jesus Christ.

Exodus 31:7 King James Version (KJV)

⁷ The tabernacle of the congregation, and the ark of the testimony, and the mercy seat that is thereupon, and all the furniture of the tabernacle,

In the Old Covenant, God would minister to man through Moses. In the New Covenant, God now ministers to man through Jesus Christ. Since His ascension to heaven, Jesus Christ has been seated at the mercy seat waiting and responding to those that come to Him seeking mercy.

Exodus 33:9 King James Version (KJV)

⁹ And it came to pass, as Moses entered into the tabernacle, the cloudy pillar descended, and stood at the door of the tabernacle, and the Lord talked with Moses.

God has mercy for everyone. His mercies cannot be exhausted. His mercies are also new every day. Man can also rebound back to Jesus Christ for mercy infinite times. God is so vast that He can dispense His mercies to billions of people at the same time. His mercies are available to and for all.

Exodus 34:7 King James Version (KJV)

⁷ Keeping mercy for thousands, forgiving iniquity and transgression and sin, and that will by no means clear the guilty; visiting the iniquity of the fathers upon the children, and upon the children's children, unto the third and to the fourth generation.

In the set up of the heavenly realm, the mercy seat is a vital part of this. God created man. God knew before the foundation of the world that man would need mercy. He has therefore created an enablement platform and process that will help, equip and assist man in finding and securing His mercies.

Exodus 35:12 King James Version (KJV)

¹² The ark, and the staves thereof, with the mercy seat, and the vail of the covering,

The mercy seat is made of pure gold. God has made this seat so precious for man to approach and find their mercy in time of need of need. The Lord Jesus Christ is seated on a seat that is made of pure gold. There are cherubims around the mercy seat. The cherubims spread out their wings on high and cover the mercy seat with their faces one to another.

Exodus 37:6-9 King James Version (KJV)

- ⁶ And he made the mercy seat of pure gold: two cubits and a half was the length thereof, and one cubit and a half the breadth thereof.
- ⁷ And he made two cherubims of gold, beaten out of one piece made he them, on the two ends of the mercy seat;
- ⁸One cherub on the end on this side, and another cherub on the other end on that side: out of the mercy seat made he the cherubims on the two ends thereof.
- ⁹ And the cherubims spread out their wings on high, and covered with their wings over the mercy seat, with their faces one to another; even to the mercy seatward were the faces of the cherubims.

Jesus Christ is seated on high at the mercy seat. All the mercy that man will ever need is available at the mercy seat. God has not spared any mercy from man. Man can lift up anything that they need mercy for and they will find mercy.

Exodus 40:20 King James Version (KJV)

²⁰ And he took and put the testimony into the ark, and set the staves on the ark, and put the mercy seat above upon the ark:

Jesus Christ now sits and presides over the mercy seat. He will never leave the mercy seat. Man has access to the mercy seat every second, minute, hour, day, week, month and year. There are no exceptions. Jesus Christ is the High Priest that now sit at the mercy seat. Before Jesus Christ, man would work through the Levitical high priest to find mercy from God.

Leviticus 16:2 King James Version (KJV)

² And the Lord said unto Moses, Speak unto Aaron thy brother, that he come not at all times into the holy place within the vail before the mercy seat, which is upon the ark; that he die not: for I will appear in the cloud upon the mercy seat.

The mercy seat is covered by incense. The blood of Jesus Christ has already been shed for the mercy seat. There is no more sprinkling of the blood of animals required for the mercy seat. The blood of Jesus Christ has permanently secured the mercy seat.

Leviticus 16:13-15 King James Version (KJV)

¹³ And he shall put the incense upon the fire before the Lord, that the cloud of the incense may cover the mercy seat that is upon the testimony, that he die not:

¹⁴ And he shall take of the blood of the bullock, and sprinkle it with his finger upon the mercy seat eastward; and before the mercy seat shall he sprinkle of the blood with his finger seven times.

¹⁵ Then shall he kill the goat of the sin offering, that is for the people, and bring his blood within the vail, and do with that blood as he did with the blood of the bullock, and sprinkle it upon the mercy seat, and before the mercy seat:

The voice of Jesus Christ now speaks from the mercy seat. Jesus Christ sits between the two cherubims and ministers mercy, help, grace, salvation, righteousness, power, blessing and glory to those that need them.

Numbers 7:89 King James Version (KJV)

⁸⁹ And when Moses was gone into the tabernacle of the congregation to speak with him, then he heard the voice of one speaking unto him from off the mercy seat that was upon the ark of testimony, from between the two cherubims: and he spake unto him.

God is great in mercy. God is not short on mercy. God will never have a shortfall of mercy. God will never have a deficit of mercy. God's mercy is available all the time. God is not deterred by man. As long as man make the decision to receive Jesus Christ and believe God in their hearts unto His Righteousness, God's mercy is always available to man. God forgives. He forgives man of all sin, transgressions and iniquity. Once God forgives, He forgives, He does not bring man into remembrance any more.

Numbers 14:18 King James Version (KJV)

¹⁸ The Lord is longsuffering, and of great mercy, forgiving iniquity and transgression, and by no means clearing the guilty, visiting the iniquity of the fathers upon the children unto the third and fourth generation.

God's mercy is great. No matter the magnitude of one person's requirement for mercy, God has sufficient mercy for them. No matter the aggregate amount of mercy required for all people, God has sufficient mercy for everyone. His mercies abound to all of man's requirements. Man's sins can never outdo God's mercy. Man's transgressions and iniquities can never out run God's mercy.

Numbers 14:19 King James Version (KJV)

¹⁹ Pardon, I beseech thee, the iniquity of this people according unto the greatness of thy mercy, and as thou hast forgiven this people, from Egypt even until now.

Man that love God have access to His mercy at any time. His mercy is applicable to all areas of life. God's mercy never runs out. God honours man that love Him and keep His Word with mercy. Man can find God's mercy in any situation or area of need. Mercy is available all the time.

Deuteronomy 5:10 King James Version (KJV)

¹⁰ And shewing mercy unto thousands of them that love me and keep my commandments.

God is not merciful to His enemies. God mercilessly destroys His enemies. However, God wants His enemies to turn to Him. When they turn to Him, He is merciful towards them. He will receive them in the Kingdom of God through the Lord Jesus Christ.

Deuteronomy 7:2 King James Version (KJV)

² And when the Lord thy God shall deliver them before thee; thou shalt smite them, and utterly destroy them; thou shalt make no covenant with them, nor shew mercy unto them:

Mercy is right at the centre of how God operates. God gives His mercies to all His children. God is a covenant keeping God. Part of His covenant provisions is mercy. God will always keep His side of the covenant. Mercy is therefore guaranteed.

Deuteronomy 7:9 King James Version (KJV)

⁹ Know therefore that the Lord thy God, he is God, the faithful God, which keepeth covenant and mercy with them that love him and keep his commandments to a thousand generations;

God promised Abraham that He would show mercy to him and his seed. God will never renege on His promises to provide mercy. Man can come short and fall short, but God will never come short or fall short. God is always available with His mercy open and freely accessible to man.

Deuteronomy 7:12 King James Version (KJV)

¹² Wherefore it shall come to pass, if ye hearken to these judgments, and keep, and do them, that the Lord thy God shall keep unto thee the covenant and the mercy which he sware unto thy fathers:

God will always show His mercy to His people. God will always have compassion for His people. God wants to see his children become fruitful, multiply, dominate, subdue and replenish the earth. Jesus Christ was also moved by compassion in His ministry.

Deuteronomy 13:17 King James Version (KJV)

¹⁷ And there shall cleave nought of the cursed thing to thine hand: that the Lord may turn from the fierceness of his anger, and shew thee

mercy, and have compassion upon thee, and multiply thee, as he hath sworn unto thy fathers;

Man can also show each other mercy. God expects man to grant each other mercy just as He grants mercy to each person. However, the mercy shown by man one unto another is at lower lever than the mercy that is available from the mercy seat. Only the blood of Jesus Christ grants the remission of sins. Only the blood of Jesus Christ was shed at the Cross of Calvary. No other blood shall and will be shed at the Cross. It was one once and for all by Jesus Christ.

Judges 1:24 King James Version (KJV)

²⁴ And the spies saw a man come forth out of the city, and they said unto him, Shew us, we pray thee, the entrance into the city, and we will shew thee mercy.

God's mercy is always available. Man can move in and out of mercy but His mercy always remains. God's Kingdom cannot be moved or shaken. Mercy cannot be moved or shaken.

2 Samuel 7:15 King James Version (KJV)

¹⁵ But my mercy shall not depart away from him, as I took it from Saul, whom I put away before thee.

Man needs to be covered by mercy and truth all the time. God's mercy covers man at all times. Man cannot do anything outside the mercy of God. Man can always look up to God in the Name of Jesus Christ for His mercy. No matter how overwhelming man's situation can be, man can always look up Jesus Christ and trust Him for mercy.

2 Samuel 15:20 King James Version (KJV)

²⁰ Whereas thou camest but yesterday, should I this day make thee go up and down with us? seeing I go whither I may, return thou, and take back thy brethren: mercy and truth be with thee.

David walked with the mercy of God. The mercies of David are available to man today through Jesus Christ. Jesus Christ now sits at the throne and dispenses the mercy of God all the time. Man cannot function effectively outside of the mercy of God. There are many reasons and experiences that will call for God's mercy to be exerted upon man.

2 Samuel 22:51 King James Version (KJV)

⁵¹ He is the tower of salvation for his king: and sheweth mercy to his anointed, unto David, and to his seed for evermore.

God expects man to walk in truth and in His Righteousness. God expects man to walk in uprightness of heart. God's mercy comes upon those that walk in truth, His Righteousness and uprightness of heart. Man that walk in truth and His Righteousness are guaranteed the mercy of God. The mercy of God is available to generations.

1 Kings 3:6 King James Version (KJV)

⁶ And Solomon said, Thou hast shewed unto thy servant David my father great mercy, according as he walked before thee in truth, and in right-eousness, and in uprightness of heart with thee; and thou hast kept for him this great kindness, that thou hast given him a son to sit on his throne, as it is this day.

There is no other god that provides mercy. All the other gods that man serve in the form of idols of all kinds, graven and molten images, animals and Baal are all dead and not living. Mercy is living. Mercy is alive. Mercy is life. Dead gods have no life in them and hence cannot dispense nor provide life. God is living and therefore can and will provide life. God will provide mercies all the time. God is the only God that provides mercy.

1 Kings 8:23 King James Version (KJV)

²³ And he said, Lord God of Israel, there is no God like thee, in heaven above, or on earth beneath, who keepest covenant and mercy with thy servants that walk before thee with all their heart:

God is a good God. His goodness includes the giving and granting of mercy. The mercy of God lasts and endures for ever and ever. Man ought to give thanks for His mercy. Man should never take the mercy of God for granted. Man ought to worship God for the mercy that He grants upon them.

1 Chronicles 16:34 King James Version (KJV)

³⁴O give thanks unto the Lord; for he is good; for his mercy endureth for ever.

Man needs to give thanks to God for His mercy. Man should feel privileged and honoured to receive God's mercy. Man should feel blessed and highly favoured to walk in God's mercy. Man falls down many times yet God continues to extend His mercy towards man.

Man needs to approach and access God with a thanks giving attitude, heart and mindset. Man should never take mercy for granted. Man should never become too familiar with the mercy of God. Mercy is a high thing and comes only from the throne of grace.

1 Chronicles 16:41 King James Version (KJV)

⁴¹ And with them Heman and Jeduthun, and the rest that were chosen, who were expressed by name, to give thanks to the Lord, because his mercy endureth for ever;

God's heart is to always have His mercy upon His children. God does not want to take away His mercy from His children. God wants His children to walk in His mercy all the time. It is man that can find themselves in and out of mercy. God's mercy is available all the time.

1 Chronicles 17:13 King James Version (KJV)

¹³ I will be his father, and he shall be my son: and I will not take my mercy away from him, as I took it from him that was before thee:

Man needs to pass on to their household and generations their revelations on God's mercy. God operates on mercy. Man needs to know that God is always merciful so that man can turn to God and not run away from God for His mercy. Children ought to be grown knowing that they can turn to God for His mercy.

1 Chronicles 28:11 King James Version (KJV)

¹¹ Then David gave to Solomon his son the pattern of the porch, and of the houses thereof, and of the treasuries thereof, and of the upper chambers thereof, and of the inner parlours thereof, and of the place of the mercy seat,

God shows His mercy from generation to generation. If man know to turn to God at every opportunity to find mercy, man will receive more mercy and more revelation on mercy. Man needs to learn how to function with God from the perspective and context of mercy. God reveals His mercy from glory to glory. Mercy

grants opportunities. Mercy grants promotion. Mercy grants honour. Mercy grants favour.

2 Chronicles 1:8 King James Version (KJV)

⁸ And Solomon said unto God, Thou hast shewed great mercy unto David my father, and hast made me to reign in his stead.

Man needs to praise God for His mercy. Man needs to worship God for His mercy. Man needs to turn to Jesus Christ for His mercy. God's mercy is available in continuity, perpetuity and infinitely. Man can never exhaust God's mercy. God's mercy is so vast and is available for ever and ever.

2 Chronicles 5:13 King James Version (KJV)

¹³ It came even to pass, as the trumpeters and singers were as one, to make one sound to be heard in praising and thanking the Lord; and when they lifted up their voice with the trumpets and cymbals and instruments of musick, and praised the Lord, saying, For he is good; for his mercy endureth for ever: that then the house was filled with a cloud, even the house of the Lord;

Man needs to walk with and in God. Man needs to have all their hearts set on God. God has mercy for people that walk with Him and have their hearts set on Him. Man will find mercy through Jesus Christ.

2 Chronicles 6:14 King James Version (KJV)

¹⁴ And said, O Lord God of Israel, there is no God like thee in the heaven, nor in the earth; which keepest covenant, and shewest mercy unto thy servants, that walk before thee with all their hearts:

Man needs to learn to bow down before God in worship and praise for His mercy which endures for ever. The worship of God is probably one area where more revelation is needed. Man need to have the Spirit of Reverence towards God. Part of this Spirit of Reverence ought to acknowledge God for His mercy.

2 Chronicles 7:3 King James Version (KJV)

³ And when all the children of Israel saw how the fire came down, and the glory of the Lord upon the house, they bowed themselves with their faces to the ground upon the pavement, and wor-

shipped, and praised the Lord, saying, For he is good; for his mercy endureth for ever.

Praise is never in isolation. Praise is never out of context. Man praise God for His mercy. The fact that mercy is available is actually a point of and an opportunity for praise. God's mercy endures for ever and ever for man. God is dependable. God is reliable. Man can count on God for His mercy. God will never let man down for His mercy.

2 Chronicles 7:6 King James Version (KJV)

⁶ And the priests waited on their offices: the Levites also with instruments of musick of the Lord, which David the king had made to praise the Lord, because his mercy endureth for ever, when David praised by their ministry; and the priests sounded trumpets before them, and all Israel stood.

Man needs to take the mercy of God seriously. Man needs to recognise and acknowledge the significance of the mercy of God. Man need to dance to God for His mercy. Man need to sing to God for His mercy. Man need to praise God for His mercy. Man should never become too

familiar with the mercy of God to the point of not worshipping God for it.

2 Chronicles 20:21 King James Version (KJV)

²¹ And when he had consulted with the people, he appointed singers unto the Lord, and that should praise the beauty of holiness, as they went out before the army, and to say, Praise the Lord; for his mercy endureth for ever.

Man need to come together and worship together for His mercy. Man need to sing and shout together for His mercy. Mercy is no small thing that man can play with nor take for granted. Mercy is huge. Man ought to glorify God for His mercy. God's Kingdom honours the glorification. God wants man to always point to Him.

Ezra 3:11 King James Version (KJV)

¹¹ And they sang together by course in praising and giving thanks unto the Lord; because he is good, for his mercy endureth for ever toward Israel. And all the people shouted with a great shout, when they praised the Lord, because the foundation of the house of the Lord was laid.

Mercy strengthens. Mercy causes the hand of God to be upon man. Mercy causes God to come through on behalf of man. Mercy turns weaknesses to strength. Mercy turns impossibility to possibility. Man ought to call upon the mercy of God in impossible situations.

Ezra 7:28 King James Version (KJV)

²⁸ And hath extended mercy unto me before the king, and his counsellors, and before all the king's mighty princes. And I was strengthened as the hand of the Lord my God was upon me, and I gathered together out of Israel chief men to go up with me.

God never forsakes man in their bondage, captivity, slavery and oppression. Mercy comes through for man that are in bondage, captivity, slavery and oppression. Mercy frees up man. Man causes man to break through and break forth out of bondage, captivity, slavery and oppression. Mercy causes man to be released from the kings of Persia. Mercy brings and breeds freedom.

Ezra 9:9 King James Version (KJV)

God can cause man to find mercy from other man. God can cause man to find mercy from kings. God touches and turns the hearts of man and kings to give mercy to others. Man needs to know to turn to and go to God to ask for His mercy. People ought to support and help one

another. God has designed His Kingdom to be one of oneness and unity. Mercy is at the heart of all oneness and unity in God. Man can do more together in support of one another than alone. More can achieved through mercy than without.

- ¹⁹ Sihon king of the Amorites: for his mercy endureth for ever:
- ²⁰ And Og the king of Bashan: for his mercy endureth for ever:

Man need to give thanks to God who provides land for an inheritance whose mercy endures for ever.

²¹ And gave their land for an heritage: for his mercy endureth for ever:

²² Even an heritage unto Israel his servant: for his mercy endureth for ever.

Man need to give thanks to God who remembers people of low estate whose mercy endures for ever.

²³ Who remembered us in our low estate: for his mercy endureth for ever:

Man need to give thanks to God who redeems man from his enemies whose mercy endures for ever.

²⁴ And hath redeemed us from our enemies: for his mercy endureth for ever.

Man need to give thanks to God who gives food to all flesh whose mercy endures for ever.

²⁵ Who giveth food to all flesh: for his mercy endureth for ever.

Man need to give thanks to God in heaven whose mercy endures for ever.

²⁶ O give thanks unto the God of heaven: for his mercy endureth for ever.

God's mercy perfects that which concerns man. God's mercy does not forsake the works of man's hands.

Psalm 138:8 King James Version (KJV)

⁸ The Lord will perfect that which concerneth me: thy mercy, O Lord, endureth for ever: forsake not the works of thine own hands.

God's mercy cuts off man's enemies and destroys them that afflicts man's soul.

Psalm 143:12 King James Version (KJV)

¹² And of thy mercy cut off mine enemies, and destroy all them that afflict my soul: for I am thy servant.

God's mercy is gracious, full of compassion and slow to anger to His people.

Psalm 145:8 King James Version (KJV)

⁸ The Lord is gracious, and full of compassion; slow to anger, and of great mercy.

God takes pleasure in those that hope in His mercy.

Psalm 147:11 King James Version (KJV)

¹¹ The Lord taketh pleasure in them that fear him, in those that hope in his mercy.

CHAPTER 4: PROVERBS ON MERCY

Proverbs on mercy provide an additional perspective to how God's mercy works. This together with the other references to mercy in the Word of God helps man to understand the heart of God fully concerning mercy.

Man should bind God's mercy on their neck, write it on their heart and make sure that mercy does not forsake them.

Proverbs 3:3 King James Version (KJV)

³ Let not mercy and truth forsake thee: bind them about thy neck; write them upon the table of thine heart:

Man that has mercy on the poor receives happiness from God.

Proverbs 14:21-22 King James Version (KJV)

²¹ He that despiseth his neighbour sinneth: but he that hath mercy on the poor, happy is he.

²² Do they not err that devise evil? but mercy and truth shall be to them that devise good.

Man that honour God have mercy on the poor.

Proverbs 14:31 King James Version (KJV)

³¹ He that oppresseth the poor reproacheth his Maker: but he that honoureth him hath mercy on the poor.

Mercy purges iniquity from man.

Proverbs 16:6 King James Version (KJV)

⁶ By mercy and truth iniquity is purged: and by the fear of the Lord men depart from evil.

The king's throne is upheld by mercy. Mercy preserves the king.

Proverbs 20:28 King James Version (KJV)

²⁸ Mercy and truth preserve the king: and his throne is upholden by mercy.

Man that follow after mercy find life. Mercy gives and breeds life.

Proverbs 21:21 King James Version (KJV)

²¹ He that followeth after righteousness and mercy findeth life, righteousness, and honour.

Man that forsake sin shall have mercy.

Proverbs 28:13 King James Version (KJV)

¹³ He that covereth his sins shall not prosper: but whoso confesseth and forsaketh them shall have mercy.

CHAPTER 5: PEARLS ON MERCY

The remaining chapters in the Old Testament provides us with a picture and a view of how God's mercy operates. This insight broadens the perspective to the understanding of mercy.

Evil doers will not experience the mercy of God unless they repent and turn from their ways.

Isaiah 9:17 King James Version (KJV)

¹⁷ Therefore the Lord shall have no joy in their young men, neither shall have mercy on their fatherless and widows: for everyone is an hypocrite and an evildoer, and every mouth speaketh folly. For all this his anger is not turned away, but his hand is stretched out still.

God gives His mercy to man that have chosen to worship and serve Him.

Isaiah 14:1 King James Version (KJV)

¹ For the Lord will have mercy on Jacob, and will yet choose Israel, and set them in their own land: and the strangers shall be joined with them, and they shall cleave to the house of Jacob.

God establishes His mercy a king's throne. Jesus Christ sits at the mercy seat on a throne that is established in mercy.

Isaiah 16:5 King James Version (KJV)

⁵ And in mercy shall the throne be established: and he shall sit upon it in truth in the tabernacle of David, judging, and seeking judgment, and hasting righteousness.

People of no understanding will not receive nor experience the mercy of God unless they repent and turn from their ways.

Isaiah 27:11 King James Version (KJV)

¹¹ When the boughs thereof are withered, they shall be broken off: the women come, and set them on fire: for it is a people of no understanding: therefore he that made them will not have mercy on them, and he that formed them will shew them no favour.

God is of good judgement and blesses those that wait with His mercy.

Isaiah 30:18 King James Version (KJV)

¹⁸ And therefore will the Lord wait, that he may be gracious unto you, and therefore will he be exalted, that he may have mercy upon you: for the Lord is a God of judgment: blessed are all they that wait for him.

God does not release nor grant His mercy to wickedness unless they turn to Him.

Isaiah 47:6 King James Version (KJV)

⁶ I was wroth with my people, I have polluted mine inheritance, and given them into thine hand: thou didst shew them no mercy; upon the ancient hast thou very heavily laid thy yoke.

God leads people that He has mercy on.

Isaiah 49:10 King James Version (KJV)

¹⁰ They shall not hunger nor thirst; neither shall the heat nor sun smite them: for he that hath mercy on them shall lead them, even by the springs of water shall he guide them.

God will give His mercy to the afflicted.

Isaiah 49:13 King James Version (KJV)

¹³ Sing, O heavens; and be joyful, O earth; and break forth into singing, O mountains: for the Lord hath comforted his people, and will have mercy upon his afflicted.

God will have everlasting mercy to His people.

Isaiah 54:8 King James Version (KJV)

⁸ In a little wrath I hid my face from thee for a moment; but with everlasting kindness will I have mercy on thee, saith the Lord thy Redeemer.

God keeps His covenant. God keeps His mercy.

Isaiah 54:10 King James Version (KJV)

¹⁰ For the mountains shall depart, and the hills be removed; but my kindness shall not depart from thee, neither shall the covenant of my peace be removed, saith the Lord that hath mercy on thee.

God has mercy upon those that turn to Him. God will abundantly pardon and release His mercy to those that turn to Him.

Isaiah 55:7 King James Version (KJV)

⁷Let the wicked forsake his way, and the unrighteous man his thoughts: and let him return unto the Lord, and he will have mercy upon him; and to our God, for he will abundantly pardon.

God will grant His mercy upon His children who will see and experience strangers build their walls and kings minister to them.

Isaiah 60:10 King James Version (KJV)

¹⁰ And the sons of strangers shall build up thy walls, and their kings shall minister unto thee: for in my wrath I smote thee, but in my favour have I had mercy on thee.

God remembers and will grant His mercy.

Jeremiah 31:20 King James Version (KJV)

²⁰ Is Ephraim my dear son? is he a pleasant child? for since I spake against him, I do earnestly remember him still: therefore my bowels are troubled for him; I will surely have mercy upon him, saith the Lord.

God gives His enduring mercy to those that turn to Him.

Jeremiah 33:11 King James Version (KJV)

11 The voice of joy, and the voice of gladness, the voice of the bridegroom, and the voice of the bride, the voice of them that shall say, Praise the Lord of hosts: for the Lord is good; for his mercy endureth for ever: and of them that shall bring the sacrifice of praise into the house of the Lord. For I will cause to return the captivity of the land, as at the first, saith the Lord.

God will honour and supply His mercy in line with His covenant with Abraham.

Jeremiah 33:26 King James Version (KJV)

²⁶ Then will I cast away the seed of Jacob and David my servant, so that I will not take any of his seed to be rulers over the seed of Abraham, Isaac, and Jacob: for I will cause their captivity to return, and have mercy on them.

God will show mercy upon His people to return to their land.

Jeremiah 42:12 King James Version (KJV)

¹² And I will shew mercies unto you, that he may have mercy upon you, and cause you to return to your own land.

God has mercy upon the house of Israel.

Ezekiel 39:25 King James Version (KJV)

²⁵ Therefore thus saith the Lord God; Now will I bring again the captivity of Jacob, and have mercy upon the whole house of Israel, and will be jealous for my holy name;

Man need to show mercy to the poor.

Daniel 4:27 King James Version (KJV)

²⁷ Wherefore, O king, let my counsel be acceptable unto thee, and break off thy sins by righteousness, and thine iniquities by shewing mercy to the poor; if it may be a lengthening of thy tranquillity.

God provides His mercy to those that love Him.

Daniel 9:4 King James Version (KJV)

⁴ And I prayed unto the Lord my God, and made my confession, and said, O Lord, the great and dreadful God, keeping the covenant and mercy to them that love him, and to them that keep his commandments;

God's mercy is conditional on people that turn to Him and repent from their sins, transgressions and iniquities.

Hosea 1:6-7 King James Version (KJV)

⁶ And she conceived again, and bare a daughter. And God said unto him, Call her name Loruhamah: for I will no more have mercy upon the house of Israel; but I will utterly take them away.

⁷ But I will have mercy upon the house of Judah, and will save them by the Lord their God, and will not save them by bow, nor by sword, nor by battle, by horses, nor by horsemen.

Wicked man will not experience the mercy of God.

Hosea 2:4 King James Version (KJV)

⁴ And I will not have mercy upon her children; for they be the children of whoredoms.

People that choose God will experience His mercy.

Hosea 2:23 King James Version (KJV)

²³ And I will sow her unto me in the earth; and I will have mercy upon her that had not obtained mercy; and I will say to them which were not my people, Thou art my people; and they shall say, Thou art my God.

God responds to mercy with mercy.

Hosea 4:1 King James Version (KJV)

¹ Hear the word of the Lord, ye children of Israel: for the Lord hath a controversy with the inhabitants of the land, because there is no truth, nor mercy, nor knowledge of God in the land.

Man need to desire God's mercy.

Hosea 6:6 King James Version (KJV)

⁶ For I desired mercy, and not sacrifice; and the knowledge of God more than burnt offerings.

When man sow in righteousness, they reap in mercy. Mercy is a harvest.

Hosea 10:12 King James Version (KJV)

¹² Sow to yourselves in righteousness, reap in mercy; break up your fallow ground: for it is time to seek the Lord, till he come and rain righteousness upon you.

Man need to keep mercy and wait on God continually.

Hosea 12:6 King James Version (KJV)

⁶ Therefore turn thou to thy God: keep mercy and judgment and wait on thy God continually.

Observing lying vanities leads to man forsaking their own mercy.

Jonah 2:8 King James Version (KJV)

⁸ They that observe lying vanities forsake their own mercy.

Man need to love mercy.

Micah 6:8 King James Version (KJV)

⁸ He hath shewed thee, O man, what is good; and what doth the Lord require of thee, but to do justly, and to love mercy, and to walk humbly with thy God?

God delights in mercy.

Micah 7:18 King James Version (KJV)

¹⁸ Who is a God like unto thee, that pardoneth iniquity, and passeth by the transgression of the remnant of his heritage? he retaineth not his anger for ever, because he delighteth in mercy.

God swore mercy to Abraham in a covenant and will honour His covenant.

Micah 7:20 King James Version (KJV)

²⁰ Thou wilt perform the truth to Jacob, and the mercy to Abraham, which thou hast sworn unto our fathers from the days of old.

God remembers mercy.

Habakkuk 3:2 King James Version (KJV)

² O Lord, I have heard thy speech, and was afraid: O Lord, revive thy work in the midst of the years, in the midst of the years make known; in wrath remember mercy.

God's withholds mercy to wickedness.

Zechariah 1:12 King James Version (KJV)

¹² Then the angel of the Lord answered and said, O Lord of hosts, how long wilt thou not have mercy on Jerusalem and on the cities of Judah, against which thou hast had indignation these threescore and ten years?

Man should show mercy one to another.

Zechariah 7:9 King James Version (KJV)

⁹ Thus speaketh the Lord of hosts, saying, Execute true judgment, and shew mercy and compassions every man to his brother:

God has mercy and compassion upon His people.

Zechariah 10:6 King James Version (KJV)

⁶ And I will strengthen the house of Judah, and I will save the house of Joseph, and I will bring them again to place them; for I have mercy upon them: and they shall be as though I had not cast them off: for I am the Lord their God, and will hear them.

CHAPTER 6: MERCY IN JESUS CHRIST

Lastly this book looks at mercy from the perspective of the Old Testament and Jesus Christ.

Man that are merciful will have the blessing of mercy from God.

Matthew 5:7 King James Version (KJV)

⁷ Blessed are the merciful: for they shall obtain mercy.

Jesus Christ has mercy on the sinners and calls them to repentance and turning away from sin.

Matthew 9:13 King James Version (KJV)

¹³ But go ye and learn what that meaneth, I will have mercy, and not sacrifice: for I am not come to call the righteous, but sinners to repentance.

Jesus Christ has mercy to people needing healing. He grants healing to those that turn to Him.

Matthew 9:27 King James Version (KJV)

²⁷ And when Jesus departed thence, two blind men followed him, crying, and saying, Thou son of David, have mercy on us.

Jesus Christ came to provide mercy to humanity. He now sits at the mercy seat in heaven dispensing mercy all the time.

Matthew 12:7 King James Version (KJV)

⁷ But if ye had known what this meaneth, I will have mercy, and not sacrifice, ye would not have condemned the guiltless.

Jesus Christ hears the voice and cry for mercy and always responds by granting man mercy.

Matthew 15:22 King James Version (KJV)

²² And, behold, a woman of Canaan came out of the same coasts, and cried unto him, saying, Have mercy on me, O Lord, thou son of David; my daughter is grievously vexed with a devil.

Man should call upon Jesus Christ who in turn responds. His mercy responds to lunatics and restores them

Matthew 17:15 King James Version (KJV)

¹⁵ Lord, have mercy on my son: for he is lunatick, and sore vexed: for ofttimes he falleth into the fire, and oft into the water.

The mercy of God restores blindness and provides eyesight.

Matthew 20:30 King James Version (KJV)

³⁰ And, behold, two blind men sitting by the way side, when they heard that Jesus passed by, cried out, saying, Have mercy on us, O Lord, thou son of David.

God responds to plights and calls for and to His mercy.

Matthew 20:31 King James Version (KJV)

³¹ And the multitude rebuked them, because they should hold their peace: but they cried the more, saying, Have mercy on us, O Lord, thou son of David.

God does not want man to omit weightier matters such as mercy in man's walk and fellowship.

Matthew 23:23 King James Version (KJV)

Woe unto you, scribes and Pharisees, hypocrites! for ye pay tithe of mint and anise and cummin, and have omitted the weightier matters of the law, judgment, mercy, and faith: these ought ye to have done, and not to leave the other undone.

Mercy responds to all cries of mercy. His mercy runs for generations. His mercy is in full supply to those that revere Him.

Luke 1:50 King James Version (KJV)

⁵⁰ And his mercy is on them that fear him from generation to generation.

God helps in remembrance of His mercy. Mercy is part of the covenant.

Luke 1:54 King James Version (KJV)

⁵⁴ He hath helped his servant Israel, in remembrance of his mercy;

Man should rejoice in the mercy of God upon them.

Luke 1:58 King James Version (KJV)

⁵⁸ And her neighbours and her cousins heard how the Lord had shewed great mercy upon her; and they rejoiced with her.

God performs the mercy that was promised to Abraham in the covenant. God honours His covenant promise.

Luke 1:72 King James Version (KJV)

⁷² To perform the mercy promised to our fathers, and to remember his holy covenant;

God's mercy is tender and comes upon His people.

Luke 1:78 King James Version (KJV)

⁷⁸ Through the tender mercy of our God; whereby the dayspring from on high hath visited us,

God wants man to sow the mercy they receive from Him to others as well.

Luke 10:37 King James Version (KJV)

³⁷ And he said, He that shewed mercy on him. Then said Jesus unto him, Go, and do thou likewise.

Man in hell and torment see the need for mercy but there is no going back once one has landed to hell. Hell is an eternal and irreversible reality once man has landed therein.

Luke 16:24 King James Version (KJV)

²⁴ And he cried and said, Father Abraham, have mercy on me, and send Lazarus, that he may dip the tip of his finger in water, and cool my tongue; for I am tormented in this flame.

Man has to call for mercy when needed and God will respond appropriately.

Luke 17:13 King James Version (KJV)

¹³ And they lifted up their voices, and said, Jesus, Master, have mercy on us.

Man should never be shy or shy away from calling for mercy. Mercy is freely available. Man should not be deterred by their environment but should continue in their pursuit and seeking of and for mercy.

Luke 18:39 King James Version (KJV)

³⁹ And they which went before rebuked him, that he should hold his peace: but he cried so much the more, Thou son of David, have mercy on me.

God applies and uses His discretion to the dispensation of His mercy.

Romans 9:15 King James Version (KJV)

¹⁵ For he saith to Moses, I will have mercy on whom I will have mercy, and I will have compassion on whom I will have compassion.

Mercy is up to God. God is the one that supplies the mercy. Man simply asks for it and calls upon it.

Romans 9:16 King James Version (KJV)

¹⁶ So then it is not of him that willeth, nor of him that runneth, but of God that sheweth mercy.

God will have mercy on whoever He decides to supply mercy.

Romans 9:18 King James Version (KJV)

¹⁸ Therefore hath he mercy on whom he will have mercy, and whom he will he hardeneth.

Man are the vessels of God's mercy. God uses man to dispense His mercy.

Romans 9:23 King James Version (KJV)

²³ And that he might make known the riches of his glory on the vessels of mercy, which he had afore prepared unto glory,

God gives mercy to those in unbelief. Through mercy one obtains mercy.

Romans 11:30-32 King James Version (KJV)

- ³⁰ For as ye in times past have not believed God, yet have now obtained mercy through their unbelief:
- ³¹ Even so have these also now not believed, that through your mercy they also may obtain mercy.
- ³² For God hath concluded them all in unbelief, that he might have mercy upon all.

Man should show mercy with cheerfulness.

Romans 12:8 King James Version (KJV)

⁸ Or he that exhorteth, on exhortation: he that giveth, let him do it with simplicity; he that ruleth, with diligence; he that sheweth mercy, with cheerfulness.

Man should give glory to God for the mercy He has made available to them.

Romans 15:9 King James Version (KJV)

⁹ And that the Gentiles might glorify God for his mercy; as it is written, For this cause I will confess to thee among the Gentiles, and sing unto thy name.

God gives His mercy to the faithful.

1 Corinthians 7:25 King James Version (KJV)

²⁵ Now concerning virgins I have no commandment of the Lord: yet I give my judgment, as one that hath obtained mercy of the Lord to be faithful.

Man should faint not because of the mercy of God they have received.

- 2 Corinthians 4:1 King James Version (KJV)
- 4 Therefore seeing we have this ministry, as we have received mercy, we faint not;

Man cannot walk outside of the mercy of God. Man can only walk in the mercy of God.

Galatians 6:16 King James Version (KJV)

¹⁶ And as many as walk according to this rule, peace be on them, and mercy, and upon the Israel of God.

God is rich in mercy and has given His mercy to His children.

Ephesians 2:4 King James Version (KJV)

⁴ But God, who is rich in mercy, for his great love wherewith he loved us,

God provides mercy for healing. Healing is mercy in manifestation.

Philippians 2:27 King James Version (KJV)

²⁷ For indeed he was sick nigh unto death: but God had mercy on him; and not on him only, but on me also, lest I should have sorrow upon sorrow.

Man need to rest and function on and in mercy each day. Man cannot function outside of mercy.

1 Timothy 1:2 King James Version (KJV)

² Unto Timothy, my own son in the faith: Grace, mercy, and peace, from God our Father and Jesus Christ our Lord.

God gives His mercy freely.

1 Timothy 1:13 King James Version (KJV)

¹³ Who was before a blasphemer, and a persecutor, and injurious: but I obtained mercy, because I did it ignorantly in unbelief.

Man obtain mercy so that God can work through them.

1 Timothy 1:16 King James Version (KJV)

¹⁶ Howbeit for this cause I obtained mercy, that in me first Jesus Christ might shew forth all long-suffering, for a pattern to them which should hereafter believe on him to life everlasting.

Man will always have need for God's mercy. God will grant and provide His mercy to those that turn to Him and repent from their own ways.

2 Timothy 1:18 King James Version (KJV)

¹⁸ The Lord grant unto him that he may find mercy of the Lord in that day: and in how many things he ministered unto me at Ephesus, thou knowest very well.

Each day, through the day and the evening, man needs to call upon the mercy of God. The mercy of God is needed at all times.

Titus 1:4 King James Version (KJV)

⁴ To Titus, mine own son after the common faith: Grace, mercy, and peace, from God the Father and the Lord Jesus Christ our Saviour.

God has saved man according to His mercy. Mercy is a gift from God.

Titus 3:5 King James Version (KJV)

⁵ Not by works of righteousness which we have done, but according to his mercy he saved us, by the washing of regeneration, and renewing of the Holy Ghost;

Man should boldly go before the throne of God to find mercy. Jesus Christ is seated in the mercy seat.

Hebrews 4:16 King James Version (KJV)

¹⁶ Let us therefore come boldly unto the throne of grace, that we may obtain mercy, and find grace to help in time of need.

The cherubims of glory shadow the mercy seat with their wings. Jesus Christ sits at the mercy seat dispensing mercy all the time.

Hebrews 9:5 King James Version (KJV)

⁵ And over it the cherubims of glory shadowing the mercy seat; of which we cannot now speak particularly.

Man that count the blood of Jesus Christ unworthy will not find mercy. God will have His vengeance upon the people that will count the blood of Jesus Christ unworthy. God will judge all the people that will count the blood of Jesus Christ as unworthy.

Hebrews 10:28-30 King James Version (KJV)

²⁸ He that despised Moses' law died without mercy under two or three witnesses:

²⁹ Of how much sorer punishment, suppose ye, shall he be thought worthy, who hath trodden under foot the Son of God, and hath counted the blood of the covenant, wherewith he was sanctified, an unholy thing, and hath done despite unto the Spirit of grace?

³⁰ For we know him that hath said, Vengeance belongeth unto me, I will recompense, saith the Lord. And again, The Lord shall judge his people.

God shall have judgement without mercy.

James 2:13 King James Version (KJV)

¹³ For he shall have judgment without mercy, that hath shewed no mercy; and mercy rejoiceth against judgment.

God's wisdom is full of mercy.

James 3:17 King James Version (KJV)

¹⁷But the wisdom that is from above is first pure, then peaceable, gentle, and easy to be intreated, full of mercy and good fruits, without partiality, and without hypocrisy.

God has mercy and His mercy comes through for those that are patient as was Job.

James 5:11 King James Version (KJV)

¹¹ Behold, we count them happy which endure. Ye have heard of the patience of Job, and have seen the end of the Lord; that the Lord is very pitiful, and of tender mercy.

God's abundant mercy has begotten us as His children through Jesus Christ.

1 Peter 1:3 King James Version (KJV)

³ Blessed be the God and Father of our Lord Jesus Christ, which according to his abundant mercy hath begotten us again unto a lively hope by the resurrection of Jesus Christ from the dead,

God has granted His mercy and made it free and abundantly available to those that choose Him.

1 Peter 2:10 King James Version (KJV)

¹⁰ Which in time past were not a people, but are now the people of God: which had not obtained mercy, but now have obtained mercy.

Each person needs God's mercy to be upon them in all their walk with Him.

2 John 3 King James Version (KJV)

³ Grace be with you, mercy, and peace, from God the Father, and from the Lord Jesus Christ, the Son of the Father, in truth and love.

Man should ask for God to multiply His mercy on them. Everything in God works in the context of His mercy.

Jude 2 King James Version (KJV)

² Mercy unto you, and peace, and love, be multiplied.

Man needs to look for the mercy of Jesus Christ to eternal life.

Jude 21 King James Version (KJV)

²¹ Keep yourselves in the love of God, looking for the mercy of our Lord Jesus Christ unto eternal life.

CHAPTER 7: CONCLUSION

Every person needs the mercy of God throughout their walk with and of God. Man cannot function in God outside of the mercy of God.

The mercy of God is not a once off event. The mercy of God is a continuous provision.

God is rich in mercy. God is abundant in mercy. God has abundant supplies of mercy.

God will never run out mercy. Man will never out-demand mercy. For any demand for mercy, there is a supply for mercy.

Man needs to walk in and under mercy throughout to eternity. Man can never have a day where they say they can walk and live without mercy. Mercy is needed in all things.

²¹ Keep yourselves in the love of God, looking for the mercy of our Lord Jesus Christ unto eternal life.

Man therefore needs to looking for the mercy of the Lord Jesus Christ unto eternity. Man can never grow to the point of no longer needing His mercy. His mercy is needed continually and in perpetuity.

The mercy of God is the grace to all living. God's mercy endures forever. Man needs to learn to call upon the mercy of God that endures forever.

The mercy of God is set for all times and for all seasons and endures for ever. Psalm 36 provides a good summary of what God's mercy can do for man.

1 O give thanks unto the Lord; for he is good: for his mercy endureth for ever.

Man need to give thanks to the God of gods whose mercy endures for ever.

² O give thanks unto the God of gods: for his mercy endureth for ever.

Man need to give thanks to the Lord of lords whose mercy endures for ever.

³O give thanks to the Lord of lords: for his mercy endureth for ever.

Man need to give thanks to God who does great wonders whose mercy endures for ever.

⁴ To him who alone doeth great wonders: for his mercy endureth for ever.

Man need to give thanks to God who by wisdom made the heavens whose mercy endures for ever.

⁵ To him that by wisdom made the heavens: for his mercy endureth for ever.

Man need to give thanks to God who stretched out the earth above the waters whose mercy endures for ever.

⁶ To him that stretched out the earth above the waters: for his mercy endureth for ever.

Man need to give thanks to God who made great lights whose mercy endures for ever.

⁷To him that made great lights: for his mercy endureth for ever:

Man need to give thanks to God who made the sun to rule the day whose mercy endures for ever.

⁸ The sun to rule by day: for his mercy endureth for ever:

Man need to give thanks to God who made the moon and stars that rule by night whose mercy endures for ever.

Man need to give thanks to God who smote the Egypt whose mercy endures for ever.

¹⁰ To him that smote Egypt in their firstborn: for his mercy endureth for ever:

Man need to gives thanks to God who delivered Israel whose mercy endures for ever.

¹¹ And brought out Israel from among them: for his mercy endureth for ever:

Man need to gives thanks to God whose strong hand and stretched out arm delivered Israel from Egypt whose mercy endures for ever.

¹² With a strong hand, and with a stretched out arm: for his mercy endureth for ever.

Man need to give thanks to God who delivered the Red sea into parts whose mercy endures for ever.

¹³ To him which divided the Red sea into parts: for his mercy endureth for ever:

Man need to give thanks to God who created a way through the Red sea whose mercy endures for ever.

¹⁴ And made Israel to pass through the midst of it: for his mercy endureth for ever:

Man need to give thanks to God who enable Israel to pass through the Red sea and overthrew Pharaoh and his host whose mercy endures for ever.

¹⁵ But overthrew Pharaoh and his host in the Red sea: for his mercy endureth for ever.

Man need to give thanks to God who leads His people through the wilderness whose mercy endures for ever.

¹⁶ To him which led his people through the wilderness: for his mercy endureth for ever.

Man need to give thanks to God who smites great things whose mercy endures for ever.

¹⁷To him which smote great kings: for his mercy endureth for ever:

Man need to give thanks to God who slays famous kings whose mercy endures for ever.

- ¹⁹ Sihon king of the Amorites: for his mercy endureth for ever:
- ²⁰ And Og the king of Bashan: for his mercy endureth for ever:

Man need to give thanks to God who provides land for an inheritance whose mercy endures for ever.

- ²¹ And gave their land for an heritage: for his mercy endureth for ever:
- ²² Even an heritage unto Israel his servant: for his mercy endureth for ever.

Man need to give thanks to God who remembers people of low estate whose mercy endures for ever.

²³ Who remembered us in our low estate: for his mercy endureth for ever:

Man need to give thanks to God who redeems man from his enemies whose mercy endures for ever.

²⁴ And hath redeemed us from our enemies: for his mercy endureth for ever.

Man need to give thanks to God who gives food to all flesh whose mercy endures for ever.

²⁵ Who giveth food to all flesh: for his mercy endureth for ever.

Man need to give thanks to God in heaven whose mercy endures for ever.

²⁶ O give thanks unto the God of heaven: for his mercy endureth for ever.

God's mercy perfects that which concerns man. God's mercy does not forsake the works of man's hands.

Man therefore need to learn to walk in the mercy of God. Man needs to function in the mercy of God. Man need to operate in the fullness of the mercy of God.
